



MASSES RESUME

The faithful remain dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligations.

- 50% Occupancy in the Church at each Mass
- Parish Hall available for overflow as needed
- Communion will NOT be distributed in parking lots
- All Mass will be livestreamed (seascc.org under Worship > Watch Us Live or on facebook.com/seaskeller)

ATTENDEE GUIDELINES

All those who enter the Church building:

- Wear a Mask
- Remain 6 feet apart
- Wash or sanitize hands
- Follow posted signage
- Listen to staff & usher instructions



DURING MASS NO...

- Exchange of peace
- Chalice distribution
- Worship aids or song books
- Passing of the collection baskets (instead at Church exits)
- Congregating before or after



The Church is disinfected after each Liturgy.

COMMUNION

- Eucharistic Ministers will wear masks and will sanitize hands
- Blessed Sacrament **only** distributed into the hand

Homebound may request communion (see Candy in the Narthex).

- Distributed following guidelines above
- Given outside home when possible



OTHER SACRAMENTS

- Follow these norms where applicable
- Confessions will be held at the entrances to the Church, just inside the doors (rather than the confessionals)

STAY HOME IF...

- You have **preexisting conditions** or are **immunocompromised**
- You are **feeling sick**
- You **suspect you may be sick** or have been **exposed to COVID-19**
- You have a **sick family member** at home
- You are **over the age of 60 or their caretaker** (recommended)



In-person catechesis, faith formation, ministry events, and parish meetings remain suspended, with a few exceptions. Prior diocesan and parish approval required and strict meeting guidelines are in place for those approved. The parish offices and Church will be open Monday-Thursday from 8:00am-4:00pm and Friday from 8:00am-noon.
